9. The Deception of the Sin Nature Will Be Designed to Keep Believers from Gaining a **God-Centered** Perspective of Sin (i.e. Seeing **Sin** as God Sees It)

- a. A God-Centered Perspective of Sin Is One That Knows and Believes God Really **Hates** Sin of Lev. 20:23; Psalm 5:4-5; 11:5; Prv. 6:16-19; Prv. 15:9; 16:5; Hosea 9:15; Ezk. 25:17; Zech. 8:17; Nah 1:2-6; Jn. 3:36; Rm. 1:18; 2:5; 5:9; Eph. 5:6; Col. 3:5-6; Heb. 1:8-9; Rev. 2:6; Rev. 6:16-17; 19:11-21; and Knows and Believes The Believer Is to **Hate** Sin Psalm 97:10; 119:104; Prv. 8:13; Amos 5:15; Rm. 12:9; Jude 23
- b. A God-Centered Perspective of Sin Knows And Believes That One's Personal Sin(s) Might Be a **Defiant** and Definitely Is a Personal **Insult** to God of Prv. 14:31; 17:5
- c. A God-Centered Perspective of Sin Knows and Believes One's Sins Are **Against** God of Gen. 20:6; 39:9; Lev. 6:1-3; Nu. 16:3; 26:9; 27:3; 2 Sam. 12:9, 13; Psalm 51:4; Lk. 15:18, 21; Acts 5:3-4
- d. A God-Centered Perspective Knows and Believes That One's Sins Are **Disgusting, Repulsive, Utterly Repugnant** to God of Deut. 7:26; Prv. 3:32; 6:16; 11:1; 16:5; 20:10; 20:23; Jer. 6:15; Jer.7:9-10; 8:12; Jer. 16:18; 32:35; Ezk. 6:9, 11; 8:6, 13
