### *Differences Between Human Emotional Enthusiasm and Biblical Zeal Demonstrated by the Zeal of David*

<b><i>Emotional Human Enthusiasm</i></b>	<b><i>Biblical Zeal</i></b>
<p>When Human Emotional Enthusiasm Masquerading as Zeal is Brought into the Realm of 'Supposed Service to God' (i.e. religious realm) The <b><u>Supposed Zealot</u></b> is Really Promoting His or Her Self and is Not <b><u>Glorifying</u></b> God cf Gal. 4:17 with Gal. 6:13; Philipp. 3:4-6 with Gal. 1:14, 21-24; Acts 22:3; 2 Ki. 10:16 with 2 Ki. 10:29-31; Jn. 16:2 with Acts 4:17, 21; 5:17, 33, 49; 8:3; 9:1-2; 14:15, 19; 17:13; 18:12; 19:23-42; 20:27-31; Rm. 2:17, 23; 10:2-4</p>	<p>Will always <b><u>Glorify / Honor the Lord</u></b>; The Examples of <b><i>David</i></b> cf 1 Sam. 17:23-50; Psalm 69:9; 132:1-5; 2 Sam. 7:1-2; 1 Chr. 22:1-5, 6-19; 10:21; <b><i>Elijah</i></b> cf 1 Ki. 19:10, 14; <b><i>Meshach, Shadrach, Abednego</i></b> cf Dan 3:1-30; <b><i>Daniel</i></b> cf Dan. 6:1-28; <b><i>Stephen</i></b> cf Acts 6:8-7:64</p>

<p>Must Continually Be Stimulated with <b><u>Promises</u></b> of <b><u>Blessings</u></b> to Move One to Give Unto the Lord: <i>Word of Faith Movement / Faith Promise Giving</i></p>	<p>Will be Move by <b><u>Love</u></b> for the Lord and <i>Having Been Blessed</i> by the Lord to Give Unto the Lord in Accordance with New Testament Teaching</p>

- B. David Intently Desired to Spread the **Fame** of the Lord by Building the Temple of 1 Chr. 22:5

4. To Spread the Fame of the Lord Believers Must Make it the **Priority** of Their Lives of 1 Cor. 10:31
5. **How** Believers Can Spread the Fame of the Lord
  - a. Follow the **Example** of Jesus and Live in **Obedience** to God's Word / Will of 1 Cor. 11:1; Eph. 5:1-2; 1 Thess. 1:6 with Jn. 5:30; 6:38; 13:31-32 of 2 Cor. 9:13
  - b. **Bear** Much Fruit of Jn. 15:8; Philipp. 1:11
    - 1) **Bear** Fruit of Jn. 15:8
      - a) To Bear Fruit Which Glorifies God One Must Be a **Believer** in Jesus Christ of Jn. 15:4-5 of Jn. 6:56; 1 Jn. 2:24; 4:15
      - b) To Bear Fruit Which Glorifies God the Believer Must **Continue** to Abide in Christ of Jn. 15:4-5
      - c) It Is of the Utmost Importance to Have As Clear and Accurate **Understanding** of the Greek Word Translated 'Abide' or 'Remain', The Word Is (μένω); English Transliteration *meno* in the Context of Jn. 15:1-8, As We Can; The Word (μένω); English Transliteration *meno* Is Used Seven Times in These Verses and Is an **Important** Word
        - i. The Verbal (μένω); English Transliteration *meno* Is in the **Active** Voice Every Time It Is Used in Jn. 15:1-8 Revealing That Believers Must **Actively** Produce the 'Abiding' or 'Remaining' in Jesus to Bear Fruit That Glorifies God

- ii. 'To Abide' or 'Remain' The Greek Word (μένω); English Transliteration *meno* in Christ in This Context Expresses the Thought of Taking up **Residence** in and Continually Carrying Out the Activity of **Living** Life Walking by Faith in the Sphere of Christ, Drawing the Life Energizing Sap Which Comes from the Power of the Holy Spirit and Obedience to *the Wisdom from His Word, Which Reveals by Commandments, Promises, Precepts and Examples* the Way We Are to Live in Order to Glorify the Lord cf Mt. 10:11; Mk. 6:10 Lk. 1:56; 8:27; 9:4; 10:7; Jn. 7:9; 10:7; 11:54; 15:9-10; Acts 9:43; 16:15; 18:3; 28:16; 1 Cor. 7:20, 24; 1 Jn. 2:10, 14, 27-28; 3:9, 14-15; 3:17, 24; 4:12, 16; 2 Jn. 2, 9
- iii. Practically Speaking 'to abide in Christ' Requires Believers 'to **Walk** as **Christ** cf 1 Jn. 2:6: Jesus Walked by **Faith** in God, by the **Power** of God, in **Obedience** to God cf Mt. 4:3-10; 27:50; Lk. 23:46; Jn. 5:30; 7:16; 12:49; 14:10; 15:10
