<p>When Human Emotional Enthusiasm Masquerading as Zeal is Brought into the Realm of 'Supposed Service to God' (i.e. religious realm) The Supposed <b><u>Zealot</u></b> is Really Promoting His or Her Self and is Not <b><u>Glorifying</u></b> God cf Gal. 4:17 with Gal. 6:13; Philipp. 3:4-6 with Gal. 1:14, 21-24; Acts 22:3; 2 Ki. 10:16 with 2 Ki. 10:29-31; Jn. 16:2 with Acts 4:17, 21; 5:17, 33, 49; 8:3; 9:1-2; 14:15, 19; 17:13; 18:12; 19:23-42; 20:27-31; Rm. 2:17, 23; 10:2-4</p>	<p>Will always <b><u>Glorify / Honor the Lord</u></b>; The Examples of <b><i>David</i></b> cf 1 Sam. 17:23-50; Psalm 69:9; 132:1-5; 2 Sam. 7:1-2; 1 Chr. 22:1-5, 6-19; 10:21; <b><i>Elijah</i></b> cf 1 Ki. 19:10, 14; <b><i>Meshach, Shadrach, Abednego</i></b> cf Dan 3:1-30; <b><i>Daniel</i></b> cf Dan. 6:1-28; <b><i>Stephen</i></b> cf Acts 6:8-7:64</p>
