Believers 'May Approve Things' / 'Be Able to Discern' / 'Help You Determine' Is the Translation of the Greek Verb (δοκιμάζω); English Transliteration dokimazo; Literally Means 'to Assay, Test'; in the Context the Word Means 'to Dissect' (i.e. Take apart and carefully analyze) Discern and Decide or in a Single Word: Determine (the determining comes after carefully analyzing) of Lk. 12:56; Rm. 2:18; 12:2; 14:22; 1 Cor. 3:13; 2 Cor. 8:22; 13:15; Eph. 5:8, 10; 1 Thess. 5:21; 1 Tim. 3:10; 1 Jn. 4:1

Things That 'Are Excellent' I 'Is Best' is the Translation of the Greek Verb (διαφέρω); English Transliteration diaphero; the Word Literally Means: 'to carry through' of Mk. 11:16; Acts 13:49; 27:27; the Word May Be Used Figuratively to Denote the Most Vital Things and Things That Make a Real Difference and Therefore Are the Best of Mt. 6:36; Mt. 10:31; 12:12; Lk. 12:7, 24; Rm. 2:18; 1 Cor. 15:41; Gal. 2:6; 4:1
