Beware of the Alluring Appeal of Desires of the Sin Nature, for 'Ear Tickling' Deceitful False Teachers; Who Will Mix, Modern Man's Thinking with the Word of God and Proclaim a Message That Will Appeal to, Allure, Appease and Seem Appropriate to the Natural Man's Thinking and His Sin Nature's Fleshly Desires for Prosperity, Physical Wellness, Personal Happiness, Physical Pleasures, and the Placing of His Or Her Personal Wants and the Desire for These and Other Things ABOVE the Desire to Please and Honor the Lord; as Well as Using Pretentious Religious Pomposity That Will Be Void of Genuine Spiritual Reality (that which is Theocentric, focused on God and not Anthropocentric focused on man and glorifies God) and May Use Methods Which Have the Appearance of the Miraculous All of Which Promote forms of Modern Idolatry cf Mt. 3:22; 24:4-5, 11, 24:24; Mk. 4:19; 7:21-23; 13:5-6
