II. **What** Is Supernatural Spiritual Biblical Joy

A. Supernatural Spiritual Biblical Joy Cannot Be **Fully Explained** of 1 Pet. 1:8

*“Whom having, not seen, ye love; in Whom though now ye see Him not, yet believing, ye rejoice with joy unspeakable (KJV) **inexpressible** (NASB, ESV, NIV, NKJV) **indescribable** (NRSV) and full of glory.”* 1 Pet. 1:8

1. The Word ***Unspeakable*** (KJV) / ***Inexpressible*** (NASB, ESV, NIV, NKJV) ***Indescribable*** (NRSV) Is the Translation of the Greek Word ἀναεκλάλητος English Transliteration **anaeklaletos** the Word Is Not Used Again in the Scriptures = That Which Cannot Be Expressed in Words, Beyond Description; “. . .to which words are **inadequate**” Thayer’s Greek-English Lexicon of the New Testament
2. - a. **You Love** (ἀγαπάω) English Transliteration **agapao** Present Tense Form of the Verb Expressing ***Continual Love***; The Verb (ἀγαπάω) English Transliteration **agapao** and the Noun (ἀγάπη) English Transliteration **agape** Expressing the Believer’s Love for the Lord Conveys The Thought of The Highest and Purest Form of Intense **Adoration** One Can Have
